## **3. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 26-01: ADOPTION OF A TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 FOR UTAH INFRASTRUCTURE AGENCY (UIA) AND SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE BUDGET (JUNE 8, 2026)**

- Item presented by Mr. Jason Roberts, UIA Secretary/Treasurer
- Good revenue growth, increasing \$3.8 million
- Significant change in operating expenses, largely due to fees paid to UTOPIA and marketing (door-to-door sales)
- Third year of debt service payments increasing \$4 million
- Capital Projects increase almost \$4 million, UEN is a significant part of that
- Request to see graph in the future of all bonds issued and timeframe for when they fall off
- Proposed change in fees paid from UIA to UTOPIA – after board input, resolution will be brought forward at the next board meeting. The last adjustment to fees was FY 2023

**ACTION: Brant Hanson (Centerville City) MOVED to approve Resolution 26-01 adopting the UIA Tentative Budget for FY 2027 and setting the time and place for a public hearing (June 8, 2026). Brenda Moore (Murray City) SECONDED the motion. A roll call vote was taken - vote was unanimous.**

- Projected budget vs. adopted budget as of February 28, 2026
  - Very good revenue numbers this year, sales have been higher than expected
  - Marketing expense over due to door-to-door efforts, which brings in a lot of sales
- Financial charts
  - 10 Year Monthly Recurring Revenue (Combined UIA & UTOPIA)
    - UTOPIA revenues are increasing, mostly due to Bountiful
  - UIA Revenue v. Bond Obligation
- Questions regarding staffing increases and employee increases – adding net nine positions, proposing COLA of 2.9% and merit increase of 1.1%
