1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

The UIA Board of Directors held a board meeting on Monday, June 8, 2026. The meeting was live streamed to allow public viewing and comment. UIA Chair Derek Oyler (Brigham City) called the meeting to order at 8:32 AM and welcomed all attendees.

- **PUBLIC HEARING TO ALLOW PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2027 BUDGET FOR UTAH INFRASTRUCTURE AGENCY (UIA)**

- Changes from tentative budget to final budget highlighted:
 - Decrease Service Contract Fees Expense to UTOPIA - \$500,000
 - Decrease Size of Bond Issued – (\$500,000)
- Operating Revenues are projected to increase
- Operating Expenses have increased in marketing due to door-to-door sales
 - Discussed effectiveness and benefit of door-to-door campaign
- Most of Network Expansion is spent on connections and green field which have a good ROI
- Relocate and maintenance costs are going up in cities – primary driver of fee increase for UIA to UTOPIA
- Presented detail of fee changes proposed for service contract between UTOPIA/UIA
- The breakdown for the distribution to cities was presented. Budget was reworked based on board member requests to increase by \$100,000 from what was presented in the tentative budget.
 - Appreciation expressed for increase to payment
